BRGY. AIRPORT



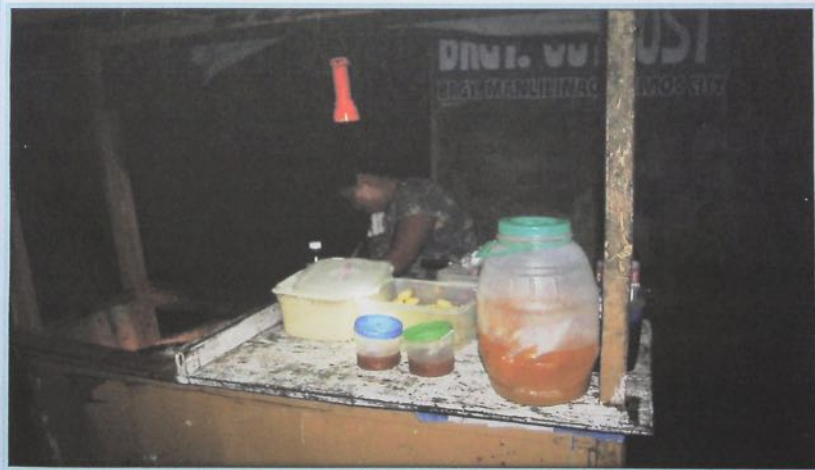

It became a barangay in 1978 under Temotia Omega as a barangay captain. As of now, it has 314 household and a population of 1,521. Recently the barangay is in the leadership of the barangay captain, Hon. Esmeralda S. Galos. Barangay Airport is a vast land of ricefield were in farming is the primary work of the people in the barangay. The barangay is one of the supplier of rice in the city. Even the barangay is small still there are many structures that can be found such as the air-conditioned barangay hall, barangay stage, covered court, barangay hall, church, multigrade school, rice mills, and the Airport of Ormoc City which is the center of attraction of the barangay. Recently the Ormoc City Airport has its domestic flight from Ormoc to Cebu and soon Ormoc to Manila will be opened. Barangay Airport is a peaceful barangay free from drugs and the people living in the barangay are friendly and hospitable.
